

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Unless otherwise regulated by a separate written agreement (hereinafter referred to as "Specific Contract") entered between the parties, **UNI-MED Szeged Egészségügyi Szolgáltató Kft.** (*UNI-MED Szeged Healthcare Service Ltd.*)—address: 6725 Szeged, Tisza Lajos krt. 107, Trade Registry No.: 06-09-0011070, Taxpayer ID №: 13882495-2-06, hereinafter referred to as UNI-MED Szeged Ltd.)—as a paid medical service center, and the patient (hereinafter referred to as: the **Patient**) hereby agree to these General Terms and Conditions (hereinafter GTC), which shall govern the provision of medical services by UNI-MED Szeged Ltd.

1. Service

UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. provides to Patient the health care service (hereinafter referred to as: the Service) financed by a private health insurance provider in accordance with the [Hungarian] Act CLIV of 1997 on Health Care, Section 3(e). UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. holds all official licenses required for the provision of the Service.

2. Liabilities of the Parties

Liabilities of UNI-MED Szeged Ltd.

- UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. agrees to provide all its Services according to the applicable laws and other professional requirements, in a professional manner, with the assistance of its employees and other contributors working in the health care sector, in accordance with the terms and conditions specified herein.
- UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. shall primarily provide the Service in the clinics and institutes of the Albert Szent-Györgyi Health Centre—operated by the University of Szeged (SZTE) and licensed as health services provider in accordance with Government Decree № 6/2003. (VII. 15.), Section 2(1)(k)—located on the following addresses: 6720 Szeged, Pécsi út 6., 6725 Szeged, Semmelweis u. 6., 6725 Szeged, Semmelweis u. 1., 6725 Szeged Semmelweis u. 8., 6720 Szeged, Korányi fasor 10-12., 6724 Szeged, Kálvária sgt. 57., 6725 Szeged, Tisza Lajos krt. 111., 6720 Szeged, Korányi fasor 14-15., 6726 Szeged, Temesvári krt. 35.
- In order to fulfill its obligations specified in this GTC and any other Specific Contract, UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. will use the assistance of other contributors as well, on any site—in addition to those mentioned above—that has all the facilities required for the Service, in accordance with applicable regulations.
- It is at UNI-MED Szeged Ltd.'s sole discretion to establish the location where and when the Services are provided, and to appoint the medical staff and other contributors. UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. shall not be bind by any special demands and wishes of the Patient.
- As a main rule, UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. shall admit the Patient at a pre-arranged appointment time to one of its paid medical service centers, or to an appropriate clinic of the Albert Szent-Györgyi Health Centre of SZTE.
- After the Patient was registered in the IT systems of UNI-MED Szeged Ltd., the latter, assisted by a medical specialist and based on the symptoms, complaints and the medical and therapeutic documentation provided by the Patient, shall give a preliminary information to the Patient regarding the recommended treatments and interventions, as well as the treatment risks and expected costs.

- UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. shall establish the total cost estimate of the Service, as well as the actual costs incurred, based on the fees specified in the Annex (Price List of Paid Medical Services), which is an integral part of this GTC.
- Outpatients shall receive the examination documentation from UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. once the examination was completed. Inpatients shall get the final report after the Service was completed and all costs and fees to be paid by the Patient have been duly settled.
- Before, during and after the Service, UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. shall provide continuous information and consultation on any issues to the Patient as well as to those contact persons who have been previously indicated by the Patient for this purpose.

Liabilities of the Patient

- The Patient hereby acknowledges and agrees that the total fee to be paid to UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. for the Services performed may not be the same as the fee specified in the preliminary cost estimate, but shall be determined after the completion of the Service, based on Patient's condition, medical interventions performed and duration of the medical care provided.
- Unless otherwise stipulated in a Specific Contract or a Specific Service Contract entered between the Parties, the Patient shall pay for the Service performed by UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. based on the applicable Price List specified in the Preliminary Quotation issued by UNI-MED Szeged Ltd.
- The Patient shall pay the total cost of the Service to UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. no later than the completion date of the Service.
- The Patient shall attend the treatments and examinations on the previously agreed dates. If the Patient is unable to attend any treatment or examination on the previously agreed date, (s)he must immediately notify UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. about this fact. If the Patient fails to send the said notification, (s)he must indemnify UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. for any consequential damages.
- The Patient shall allow UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. to perform the medical tests required by the Service and agrees to fully cooperate with the examiners during any such tests.
- The Patient shall provide the following information to UNI-MED Szeged Ltd.:
 - any information needed for diagnosing a disease, prepare an adequate treatment plan, and perform the interventions, with special regard to all previous illnesses, treatments, medication, drugs or medicinal products used, drug sensitivity, as well as health risk factors,
 - in the context of its own illness, all information about the factors that may endanger the life or physical integrity of others, with special regard to infectious diseases and occupational diseases, and conditions,
 - all his/her prior legal statements concerning his/her own health care,
 - about his/her personal data (it is required to provide the data and provide evidence of their authenticity in a credible way),
 - data of the person entitled to represent him/her and act on his/her behalf.
- The Patient is required to fill in and sign the Statement (or Declaration) prepared by UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. and required for the professional and safe performance of the Service.

- UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. shall not be held liable for any kind of damages caused by any misconduct of the Patient.

3. Fees and Payment Terms

- The Patient shall pay to UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. a specific fee for the use of the Service based on the Price List included in the Annex to this GTC.
- In the case of outpatient care, the Patient shall pay the total cost of treatments during the registration process, before any treatment can commence.
- In the case of inpatient care, the Patient shall pay the estimated Service fee determined by UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. during registration.
- After the completion of the Service, the parties shall settle the accounts based on the total fee calculated on the basis of the actual health care services used.
- If the total Service fee exceeds the amount of the anticipated fee, the Patient shall pay the difference on or before the date of Service completion.
- If the Service fee is less than the amount of anticipated fee, UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. shall refund the difference to Patient on the day of completion of the Service.
- The fee shall be paid by Patient in cash or with a bank card, or by wire transfer by the Patient's insurance company.

4. Professional Liability

- In accordance with its liability insurance policy, UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. is solely responsible for any damages that occurred due to its own intentional or grossly negligent conduct and are explicitly and directly related to the provision of the Service or to the conduct of UNI-MED Szeged Ltd.
- The Patient acknowledges that, as it regards the Service, UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. can solely assume professional responsibility for the Service performed to the best of its knowledge, with the utmost care and diligence, which can be [reasonably] expected.
- UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. shall not be held liable for any consequences and other diseases that may result from Patient's failure to meet his/her liabilities or due to the disregard of instructions or advices received during the Service.

5. Confidentiality and Data Protection

- UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. shall handle any information regarding the personality and health condition of the Patient and collected during Service performance as confidential data falling under the provisions of Act XLVII of 1997 on the handling and protection of personal data related to or in connection with health, and may disclose this information to authorized persons only.
- UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. shall handle any personal data collected or obtained during the Service in accordance with Act CXII of 2011 on information self-determination and freedom of information, as well as provisions of other relevant and applicable laws, and only for the purpose of the Service performed.

6. Scope of the GTC

- This GTC shall generally apply to all matters not covered by a Specific Contract entered between the Patient and UNI-MED Szeged Ltd., as well as to all issues that are not expressly stipulated or otherwise regulated by a Specific Contract.
- UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. reserves the right to amend this GTC. Every amendment shall be publicly posted in the premises of UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. open to patients, as well as on the website of UNI-MED Szeged Ltd.

7. Other Provisions

- Any legal statements issued in the name and on behalf of the Patient by Patient's legal representative shall be done in accordance with the rules of representation. However, Patient's close relatives (as defined by the [Hungarian] Civil Code, Section 685(b) and Section 685/A) may act in the name and on behalf of the Patient unless otherwise stated in an explicit written statement issued by the Patient.
- This GTC was compiled in Hungarian language. If any conflict arises regarding the interpretation of this Contract or in the case of litigation, the Parties shall accept the priority of the Hungarian text.
- For the interpretation and implementation of the present GTC, or for any matters not regulated herein, the Parties shall accept the primary applicability of the Hungarian rules of law.
- The parties shall try to settle any of their disputes related to this GTC by peaceful means. If the negotiations fail, the Parties shall accept the exclusive jurisdiction of the court of the place of performance.
- UNI-MED Szeged Ltd. shall ask and allow the Patient to access and read the content of this GTC before using or registering for the Service, and the Patient shall acknowledge this fact by his/her own signature.
